Collection description: Louis Browne was born in Athlone, Ireland in 1931. He completed his studies at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London and enjoyed the distinction of being engaged by the Glyndebourne Festival Opera. He later joined the Sadler's Wells Opera Company (now the English National Opera) as principal tenor for over 10 year. He has sung in many of the world's leading venues and is one of a select number of Irish tenors to enjoy such success.
