Biographical note: Dr Yvonne McEwen is a historian Professor of History University of Wolverhampton, War and Conflicts Studies. She is also the Official Historian of the British Army Nursing Service and the Project Director of the largest World War 1 public engagement project in the United Kingdom. She is a graduate of the University of Edinburgh with degrees in nursing and history. Her latest publication '*Beneath Troubled Skies: Poems of Scotland at War 1914 1919*' was launched in November 2015. The book was produced in collaboration with the Scottish Poetry Library.

Collection description: The archive consists of 6 cardboard boxes containing Dr Yvonne McEwen's primary research papers on the First and Second World Wars. The material type consists of Reading lists, Book chapters and Articles.
